






<p>Country Mansion II and Grand Slate II</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patterning...results when a similar or same color drop is installed vertically and/or diagonally up the roof.
<p>Deviating from Installation Instructions Can Increase Patterning Risk!</p> <p>Common Installation Mistake: Color Patterning</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Risk of Patterning Occurs....when you are stair-stepping and/or filling-in and the selected shingles happen to have similar or the same colors. • Risk Increases.....with colors that are bold or are more noticeable from the curb. 
<p>A Few Simple Steps to Avoid Potential Patterning</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay attention to the shingle you select. • If you notice three similar color drops being installed vertically and/or diagonally...STOP! • Replace the problem shingle. • Check for patterning and if none is apparent, continue.
